Chairman Hal Levy called the meeting to order at 6:11 pm with ten towns represented. New members Joan McGettigan (Darien-E) and Sean Mayo (Greenwich-E) were introduced and welcomed to the Council.

- 1. Minutes of the May 29 meeting was approved.
- 2. Financial Report was distributed discussed and approved.

3. Old Business:

- Altice Connecticut Government Affairs hire is still pending, John Dullaghan, who was not in attendance, remains as the contact until someone is hired. The position has remained vacant since April 4th, 2019.
- Member appointments are pending for New Canaan, Stamford & Wilton Govt. and Stamford Edu., awaiting responses from those CEO's & Superintendents. The status of member appointments can be ascertained at a9cc.org, pending as either "vacancy" or incumbents marked with an *.
- E&G Station Information spreadsheet can be downloaded from the A9CC website at http://a9cc.org/forms.htm. Please review and send any missing information to Hal.
- There has been no change in status on FCC Docket No. 05-311 to allow cable companies to apply in-kind expenses to franchise fees, although it was reiterated that this shouldn't affect PEG in CT; HB 5486 - An Act Repealing the Transfer from the PEG Programming and Education Technology Investment Account (PEGPETIA) to the General Fund; and Proposed H.B. No. 6421 An Act Concerning The Regulation Of Cable Television Rates
- 4. **2019 Round 1 grant applications:** The following applications were considered:

This concludes 2019 Round 1 grants.

5. 2019 Round 2 grant program:

Since Round 1, there has been \$45,957 in new funding (\$25K supplemental + \$20,957 U-verse). \$22,978 will be allocated each to Round 2 Education & Government grants. \$22,000 remains in Round 1 Education funds and \$30,000 in Government funds. These amounts will be rolled over into Round 2 E&G funding pools.

On the education side: A total of \$45,000 is available for Round 2 grants, with a hard application deadline of 12/2, whereby the Education Committee will determine how to allocate the funds. Educational grant applications may include up to \$2,500 of it in operations funding, (i.e. labor costs for operating cameras & editing equipment).

On the government side: Each eligible town may apply for up to \$5,300 with up to \$2,500 of it in operations funding, (i.e. labor costs for operating cameras & editing equipment), with a hard application deadline of 12/2.

6. **Optimum system outages** from the evening of 9/6 into morning of 9/7 affected CT, NY & NJ. Altice attributed it to a power failure. The company emailed customers: "In light of the service disruption, we will be automatically issuing a credit on one of your next two monthly billing statements." (\$4.50 to \$6.50). There were many complaints about getting information from Optimum Customer Service.

7. Other Matters

- Optimum Gold was replaced with Optimum Premier on 9/19. Premier does not include Cinemax & TMC. Past Gold customers need to subscribe to those separately to retain the same level of service. However the price of Premier has been increased by \$5/mo to the level of Gold.
- Some wait times for Optimum CSR's in the call center are still excessive. Sometimes a CSR does
 not have access to the calling customer's records.
- It was reported again that some cloud DVR service lags and freezes. (Witnessed in Easton)
- Weston G is looking for service vendors to replace its tech director who retired. Hal will forward Harvey's email seeking service providers.
