\$15,000 for Educ. grants, \$35,000 for Govt. grants. 10 grants of \$3,500 on the Government side were created. The breakdown of the Educational portion is to be determined by the Ed Committee. A maximum of \$1,500 for each grant can be allocated to operations. The deadline for submitting grants from the towns & schools is 12/8/2021.

6. **Programming ideas for the access channels:** Jim spoke to an initiative to expand programming on the E&G access channels through a number of means. One is the sharing of programs amongst the Area 9 channels. An example is to make available the fine programs produced by Convent of Sacred Heart and Norwalk Community College. Dave P. will check about sharing his Google Drive of programs. Over the past year Jim found more than 200 "evergreen" shows from local libraries, non-profits and NGO's. Most reside on their YouTube channels where they can be easily downloaded using an app like <u>Vidly</u>. Jim will continue to email members on program availability.

7. Other Matters

- Esme announced some community initiatives by Altice. She will email details to A9CC members.
- Jim complimented Esme for disseminating detailed storm preparation during weather events.
- Roman announced that an Area 9 student participated in an MLB game on ESPN due to skills developed through our Educational Access activity.
